Valentine's & Chinese New Year Celebrations!



We encourage those that haven't yet completed one to do so online and return to us. It is important for us to know how well we are doing and help us to identify any areas that we could improve on.

We have recently signed up with HM
Government for Tax Free Childcare. This
is a new online Government service to help
parents pay for childcare. For every £8 a parent
pays in to their childcare account, the
Government will add an extra £2, which equates
to 20% of the overall cost. Parents can receive
up to £2000 per child, per year towards their
